Ash Tennis Club is a friendly club offering social and competitive tennis for all ages. It encourages new members to join, get fit and have fun, regardless of their age or playing ability.

ADULT MEMBERSHIP £110*

Gives full access to club courts (subject to availability) and a variety of tennis sessions which includes all social tennis (details below). Adult members are also entitled to play in the **Club Championships** and social tournaments, and they can also be invited to represent Ash Tennis Club in the Local League matches.

WEEKDAY MEMBERSHIP £50*

For a reduced fee, Weekday Members have the use of the courts during weekdays before 4 pm. They are encouraged to join social functions and play in specified events.

FACILITIES

Ash Tennis Club has three outdoor asphalt tennis courts. The top court, in front of the clubhouse, is equipped with floodlighting to facilitate late evening and Winter tennis. Floodlight tokens cost £2.00 per 30 minutes and are available from specific members of the Club.

COACHING PROGRAMME

Children aged 3 and above are encouraged to come along to our coaching programmes where they can have one free taster session to try out during a term time class. Our coaching team also Holiday Camps.

Adults are also welcome to coaching with group, one to one's, doubles practice and profiling sessions available.

Discounts are available to Members. Please see the ATC website or talk to one of our coaches.

STUDENT £50* & AWAY STUDENT £30*

For those over 16 years old and in full time education or a junior of suitable talent recognised by the Club Captains. This is a reduced rate but offers the same facilities as the Adult Membership. Away Student is for those living away from home when studying.

SOCIAL TENNIS

Club Sessions are held on Sunday mornings from 10 am with all the courts available in the Summer and one available during the Winter due to league matches. There are also two mid-week sessions on a Friday Morning from 9.30am and on Wednesday night from 6 pm with all the courts available during the Summer and the floodlit court available in the Winter. These sessions offer a great opportunity to meet other club members.

The courts are available for casual tennis throughout the year, a web based booking system is in place. When League Matches are being played, one court is always available for social tennis.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP £25

Suitable for anyone who is 16 and under. Junior members have court priority on Saturday mornings and weekday evenings from 4 pm – 6 pm. At all other times they are welcome to use the courts, but must give way to adult members.

PARENT MEMBERSHIP £10

For those adults who just want to come and play tennis with their children. Court availability is on a first come, first served basis. However should you wish to play with other adults or join in with adult social events or tournaments please look at Adult or Weekdav Membership options.

Fees are charged per annum from July - June. *Reduced rates are offered from September, please ask for further details.



<u>COURT</u> BOOKING

Booking of a court is recommended. This is done through the online Clubspark site or Booker App. Access is granted to all members.



<u>VISTORS</u>

Members can bring a guest to play at the club up to 3 times per year. A Guest Fee of £2 (£1 for Juniors) must be given to the Treasurer or paid via Internet Banking and details put in the Visitors Book, found in the clubhouse on each occasion. If a guest wished to play more than 3 times in a year, they would be expected to join the Club as a member.



The club is conscious of the varying needs of it's adult members, some of whom wish to play competitive tennis while others prefer a more relaxed and informal programme. As a consequence, the club organises a varied programme of tennis activities.

LEAGUE TENNIS: During the Summer, 1 Men's and 1 Ladies are entered into the Aldershot and District Tennis League. The fixtures take place either at home or away during weekday evenings. During the Winter 3 men's, 2 women's and 2 mixed teams compete in matches arranged on Saturday or Sunday mornings. In 2017 & 2018 we entered a Men's & Ladies Team in the Surrey Wilson Leagues. This we look to repeat in 2024. If an individual cannot commit to a regular team place there are ample opportunities to play as a reserve.


CLUB TENNIS: Each year those wishing to compete are entered into a Club Championship draw for singles, doubles, mixed and veterans doubles matches which are played during the summer months in a knock-out format with finals taking place the first weekend of September.

There are various other tournaments held throughout the year. Details are displayed in the clubhouse, advertised in the quarterly Newsletter and communicated to members via emails.

For our younger members Junior and Family events are also held.
